

Learning outcomes: B.A.(Honours)in Political Science

Students completing the requirements for a B.A. degree in Political Science will be able to:

- Write clearly and with purpose on issues of international and domestic politics and public policy.
- Participate as a socially and politically engaged member of society;
- Concepts of political science and its subfields like major structures and functions of foreign governments, basic political theories and thoughts, major concepts ,theories and institutions of public administration.
- Deliver thoughtful and well articulated presentations
- Analyze contemporary problems in the countries under consideration in light of the conceptual frameworks presented in class.
- Identify the names and geographic location of most contemporary states.
- Demonstrate an understanding of: the key historical events which shaped the International system in the 20th century, the basic structures of the contemporary International system; and the key actors, Institutions and their functions.

Learning outcomes: B.A.(Honours) in History

Students completing the requirements for a B.A. (Honours) degree in History will be able to:

- Develop an in-depth understanding of a field, theme or region.
- Demonstrate an historical awareness of the diversity of the human experience across time and space.
- Apply, assess and debate the major historical schools of thought, methodology and types of sources that historians use to make original arguments.
- Formulate historical arguments and communicate those arguments in clear and persuasive prose.
- Learn to apply historical methods to evaluate critically the record of the past and how historians and others have interpreted it.
- Acquire basic historical research skills, including the effective use of libraries, archives, and databases.
- Learn to organize and express their thoughts clearly and coherently both in writing and orally.

Learning outcomes: B.A.(Honours) in Bengali

Students completing the requirements for a B.A. (Honours) degree in Bengali will be able to:

- Learn to translate from English to Bengali and contrarily from Bengali to English.
- Acquire skill in proof-reading, formal letter-writing, reporting of various affairs etc. Exercise of all these methods will help students in getting jobs as translator, professional Proof-reader or Reporter in News agencies and thus the course of study is building proficiency required for getting employed in different field.
- Acquire multidimensional knowledge through the learning of Bengali literature and language.
- Learn and understand the essence of the wide range of Bengali literature a student can express himself or herself more intensely. Literature will also build a cultural sense in the students. They can develop their own perspective and interpretation.

Learning outcomes: B.A.(Honours) in English

Specific learning outcomes for English (Honours)

- Students will become competent enough to read complex texts actively, appreciate ambiguities and complexities inherent to quality literary works.
- They shall also develop competence to form and articulate their own interpretations with an awareness and curiosity for other perspectives, while being able to comprehend the literal and figurative uses of language.
- Students will be trained to write effectively for a variety of professional and social requirements. They will be, as far as practicable, to practice writing as a process of critical inquiry, learning the art of incorporating ideas of their own along with those of others. They will demonstrate an aptitude for grammatical and stylistic clarity.
- Students will gain a reasonable knowledge of the major traditions of literatures right from classical Europe to the cultures of our own. Pupils will also be provided with ideas of different literatures written in English like the British and the American, as well as those marginalized by them or newly emerging fields.
- Oral Communication Skills: Through an organized program that promotes active interaction, students shall be trained to listen carefully, work in collaboration to build knowledge and situate their own viewpoints within frameworks that incorporates others' ideas while articulating their own questions clearly. Students will be able to prepare, organize, and deliver an engaging oral presentation.

Learning outcomes: B.A.(Honours) in Philosophy

Students completing the requirements for a B.A. (Honours) degree in Philosophy will be able to:

- State a clear and strong objection to an argument advanced by others; and to articulate counter-arguments.
- Justify their own and evaluate others' actions using general ethical principles of the psychological account as a framework.
- Read both primary and secondary sources through the western philosophical thought and analyzing their arguments.
- To identify arguments in ordinary language, as well as distinguish premises from conclusions and also help differentiate deductive arguments from inductive arguments
- Analyze particular moral problems by applying those ethical theories which will help them examine the moral value of their own life as well as of others.
- Learn the concepts of right, wrong, good and bad in their environment and also have to learn the moral principles and their application in everyday life and develop a sense of the value of life and how living beings are connected to the world.

Learning outcomes: B.Sc.(Honours) in Geography

- Geography, as a subject, deals with the study of the origin of the earth crust and its interior along with correlative discussion on atmosphere, hydrosphere and biosphere.
- This subject broadens the outlook of students about the place where they survive, the air that they breathe in for survival and the water that they drink.
- The students come to know the cause of the natural events like Earthquake, Volcano, Tsunami, Flash flood, Cloud burst etc.
- This subject also focuses on the development of soil and its profile along with its chemical constituents which help to make it more cultivable. Thus, this subject gives an all round knowledge about the earth and its environment to the students.

After Graduation, the students can opt for jobs like schooling teaching, competitive exam like WBCS, UPSC, and Meteorological assistant in IMD. They can also get a diploma in Jute technology, Remote Sensing and GIS.

Learning Outcomes: BA General

- Students may take any three subjects from different combinations, such as Bengali, History, Political Science, Philosophy, English, Physical Education and Economics.
- Students will gain a reasonable insight to the different subjects as applicable in the job market.
- Can appear in different competitive examinations that look for fresh graduates.

Learning Outcomes: B.Sc General

- Students develop computer skills, mathematical skills and other analytical efficiencies that help them in securing a job.
